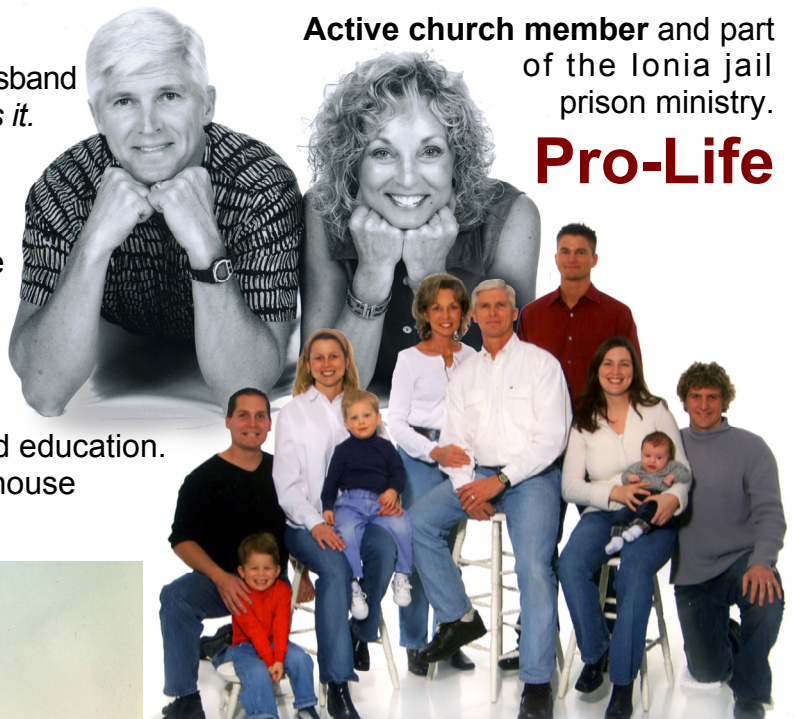

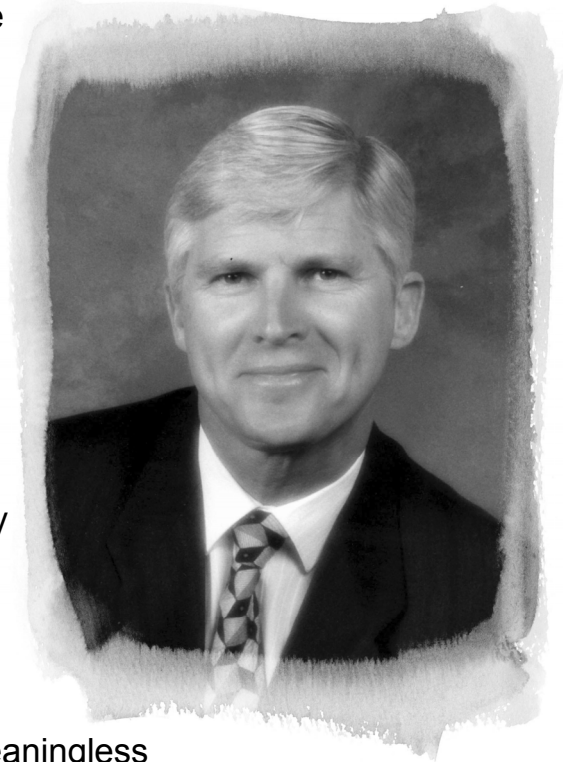

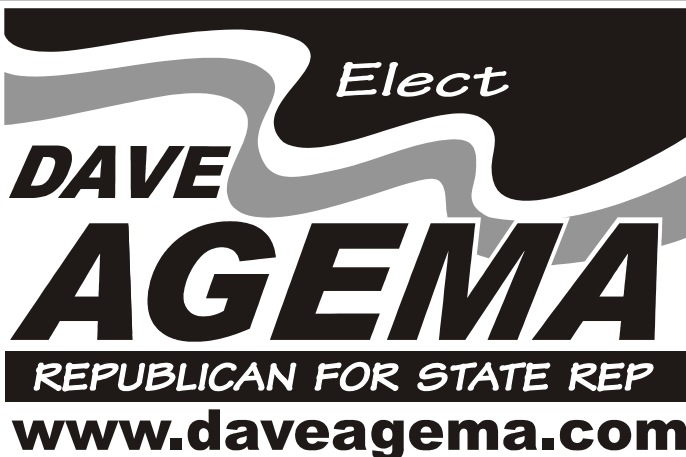
Biography
